**Subject:** Request for Inclusion of School Librarian Posts in DSC Recruitment 2026 and Issuance of a Mandatory G.O. for Librarians in All Recognized Schools – Reg.

On behalf of the forum for good governance, I appeal to the government to bring this to the attention of the School education department.

### **Respected Sir**

We, the qualified Library Science professionals and education advocates of Telangana, submit this representation with a vision to transform our state's schools into true centers of knowledge. While the Government has made historic strides in infrastructure and digital education, a critical pillar of learning remains neglected The School Library.

We wish to bring the following points to your urgent attention

### **1. The Gap Between Policy and Reality**

As per G.O. Ms. No. 538. 20-11- (1998) and G.O. Ms. No. 96 25-07- (2005), the state recognized the necessity of librarians. However, despite over 21,519 government schools having physical library facilities, they remain "locked rooms" or mere "book storehouses" because there are no professionals to manage them. Without a librarian, these resources are effectively wasted.

### **2. Compliance with the Telangana Education Commission 2026**

The Commission's recent report explicitly recommends that every government school—both Primary and High School—must have a dedicated librarian. The Commission recognizes that librarians are essential for Fostering a lifelong reading habit. Supporting teachers with research materials. Bridging the gap between classroom learning and independent inquiry.

### **3. Aligning with National Standards (NEP 2020)**

The National Education Policy (NEP) describes the library as the "Heart of the School." Central institutions like KVS, NVS, and EMRS, along with our own Gurukulam schools, have proven that a professional librarian significantly improves student literacy levels. It is time this standard is applied to every child in Telangana.

### **4. Regulating Private Recognized Schools**

Many private schools collect library fees but do not employ qualified librarians. To ensure quality education is not a privilege of the few, we request a Special G.O. making it

mandatory for all Private Recognized Schools to hire qualified Library Science graduates, mirroring CBSE and National norms.

Thousands of Library Science graduates are currently unemployed. By including Librarian posts in the DSC Recruitment 2026, the government will not only fulfill a vital educational need but also provide dignified livelihoods to thousands of qualified youth who are eager to serve the state.

### **OUR HUMBLE PRAYER**

**We Are earnestly request your office to take the following actions Forward department**

**DSC 2026 Inclusion:** Immediately sanction and include School Librarian posts in the upcoming DSC 2026 notification for both Primary and High Schools.

**Mandatory G.O.:** Issue a directive making it compulsory for Private Recognized Schools to appoint qualified librarians to maintain their recognition.

**Active Learning Centers:** Formulate a policy to transform existing school libraries into "Active Learning Centers" under professional guidance.

We believe that under your visionary leadership, Telangana can lead the nation in creating a "Reading Revolution." We look forward to your positive intervention.
